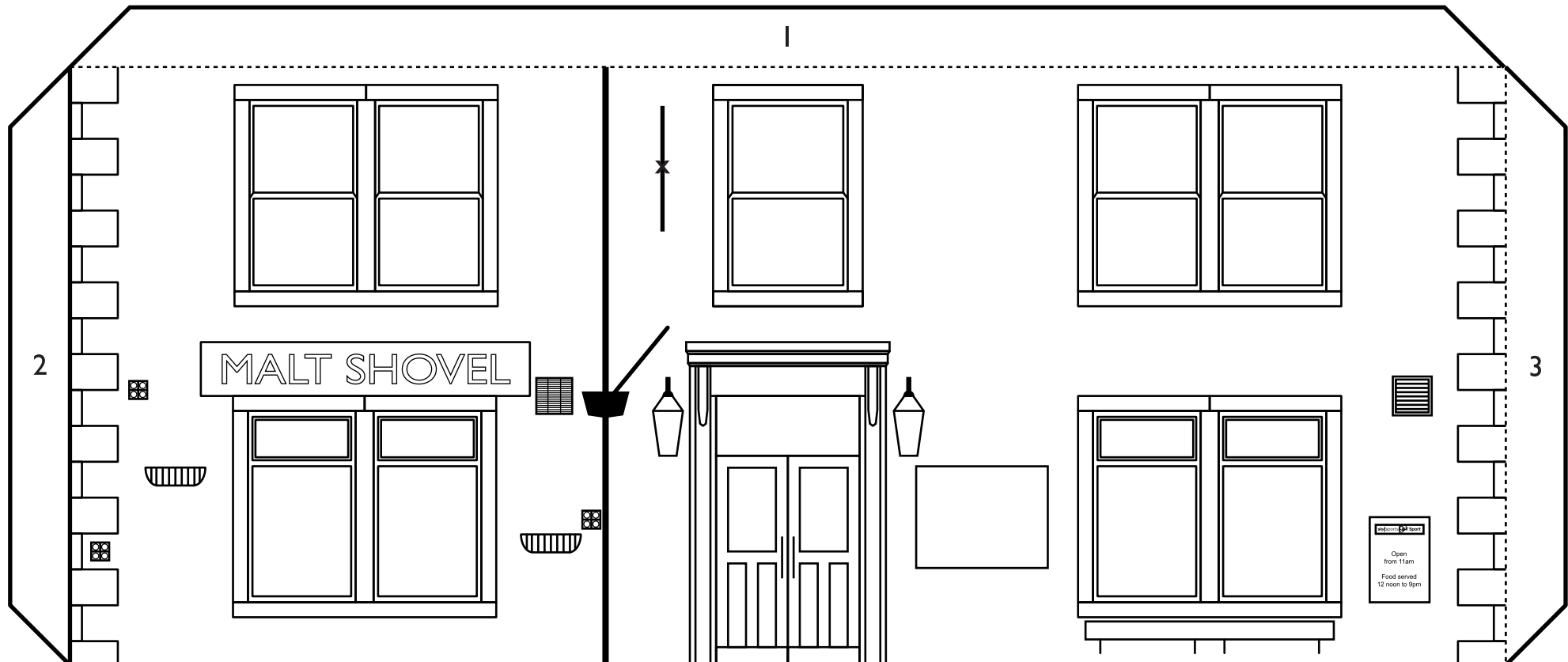
Cut along thick lines 

Fold along dashed lines 

Part AX - Sign

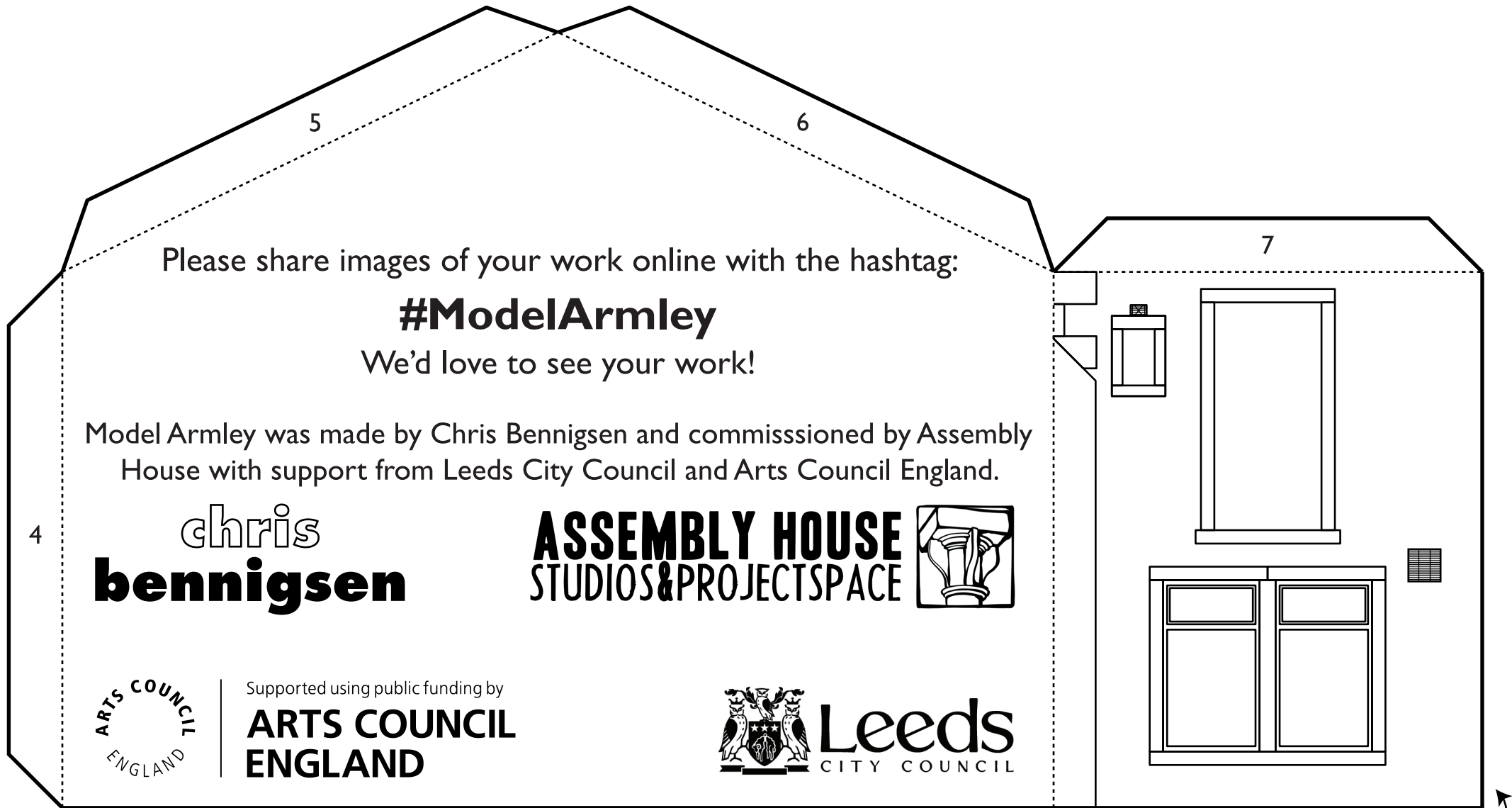


Part A - Front wall, right hand side



Cut and fold **Part A**, ensuring you cut a slit on the line marked with an **X**. Cut and fold **Part AX** in on itself so it is double-sided. Fold tab **X** on the right angle and insert into the **X**-marked slit, gluing to the inside of the wall.

Part B - Front wall, left hand side, and left wall

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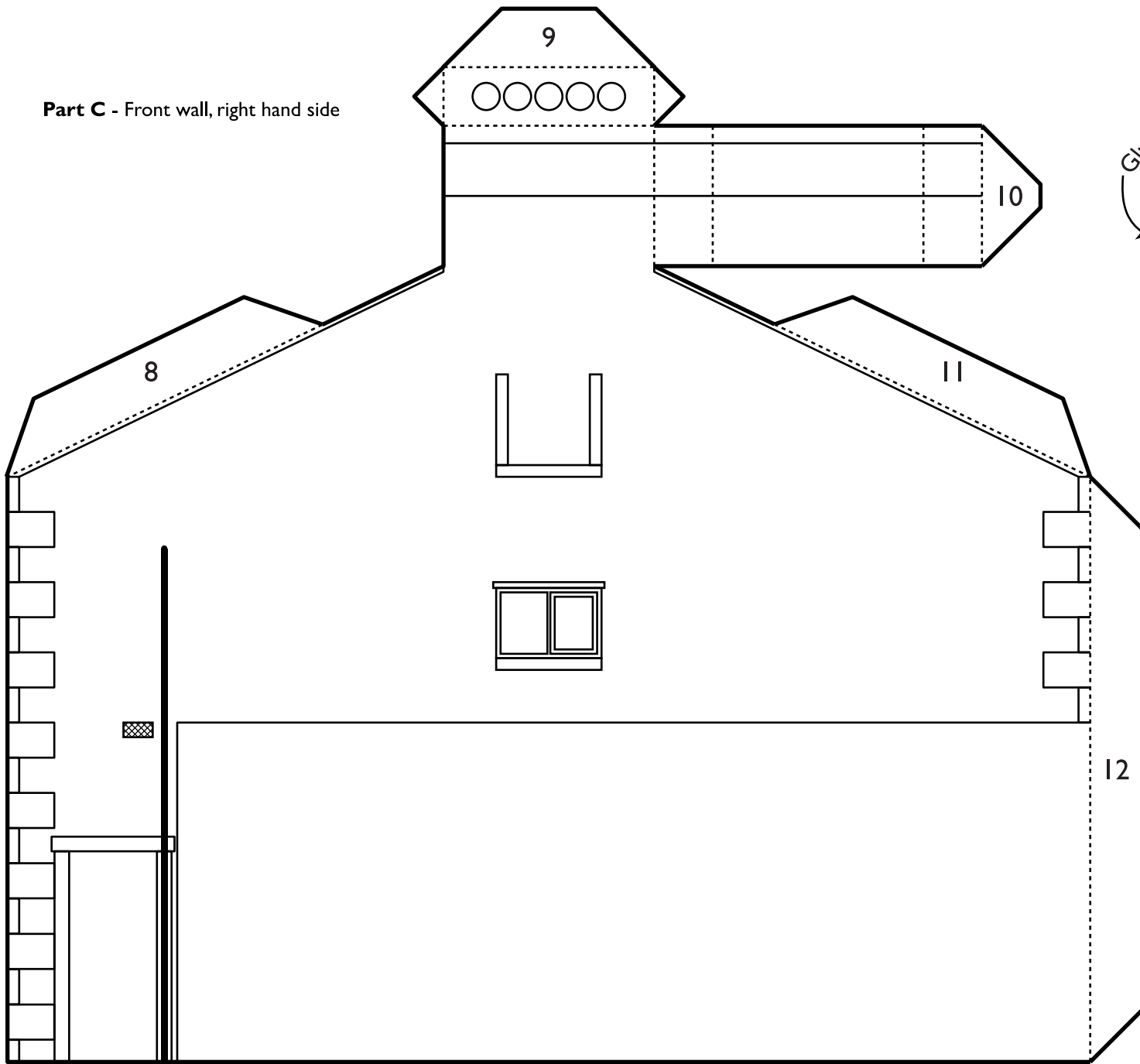

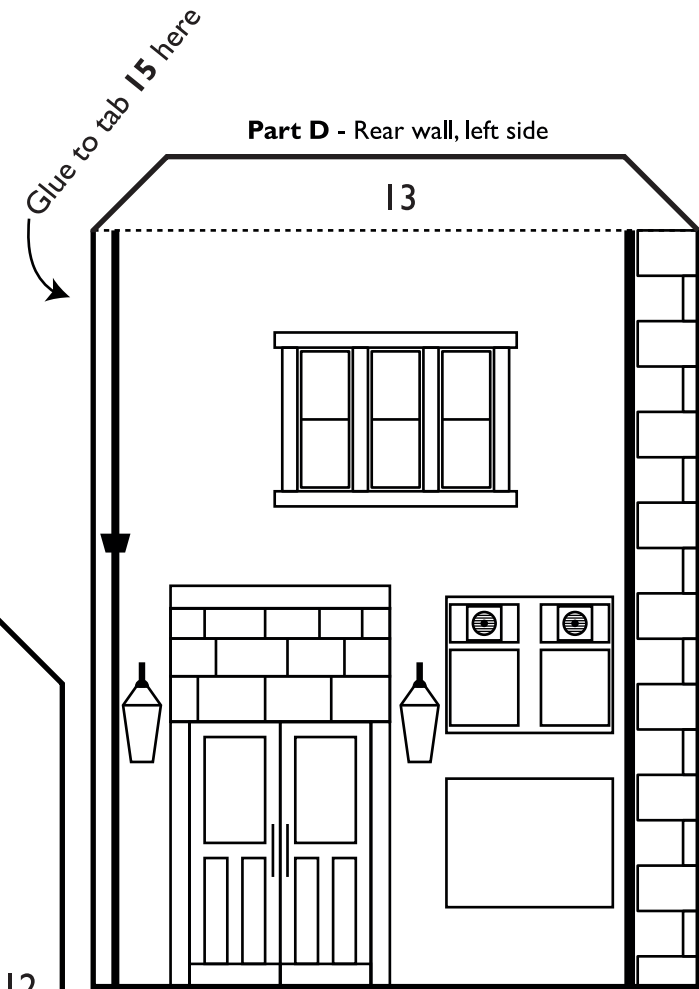
Cut and fold **Part B**, gluing tab **2** behind the the cut piece where indicated

Glue tab **2** here 

Part C - Front wall, right hand side



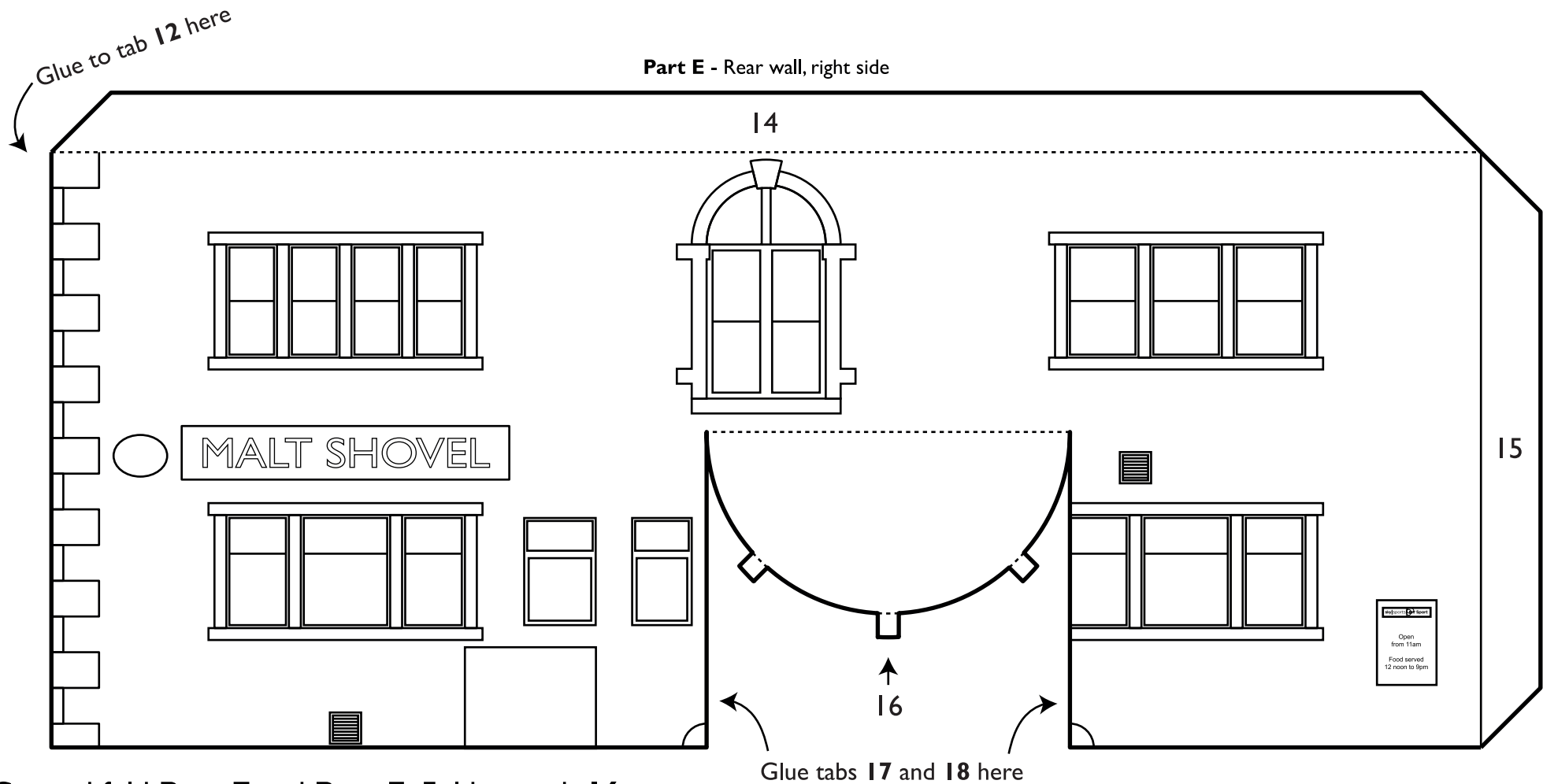
Part D - Rear wall, left side



Cut and fold **Part C**, gluing to tab **3** on **Part A** as indicated. Assemble the chimney by folding and gluing tabs **9** and **10**, and the small tabs, in on themselves to make a box shape.

Cut and fold **Part D** and leave to one side for the time being.

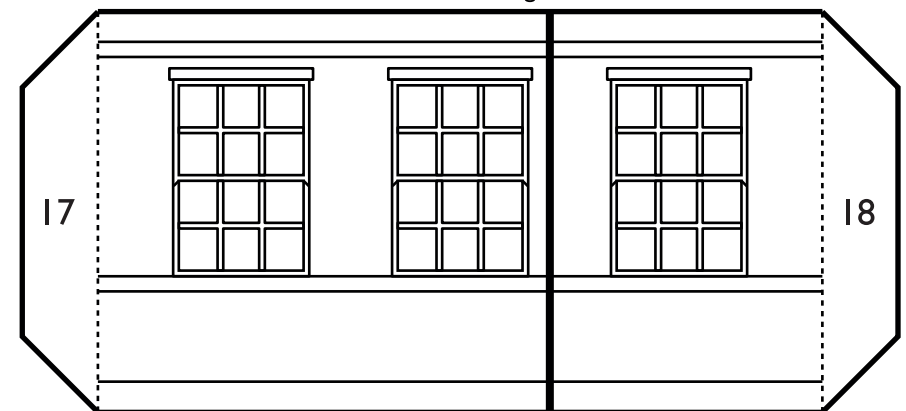
Part E - Rear wall, right side

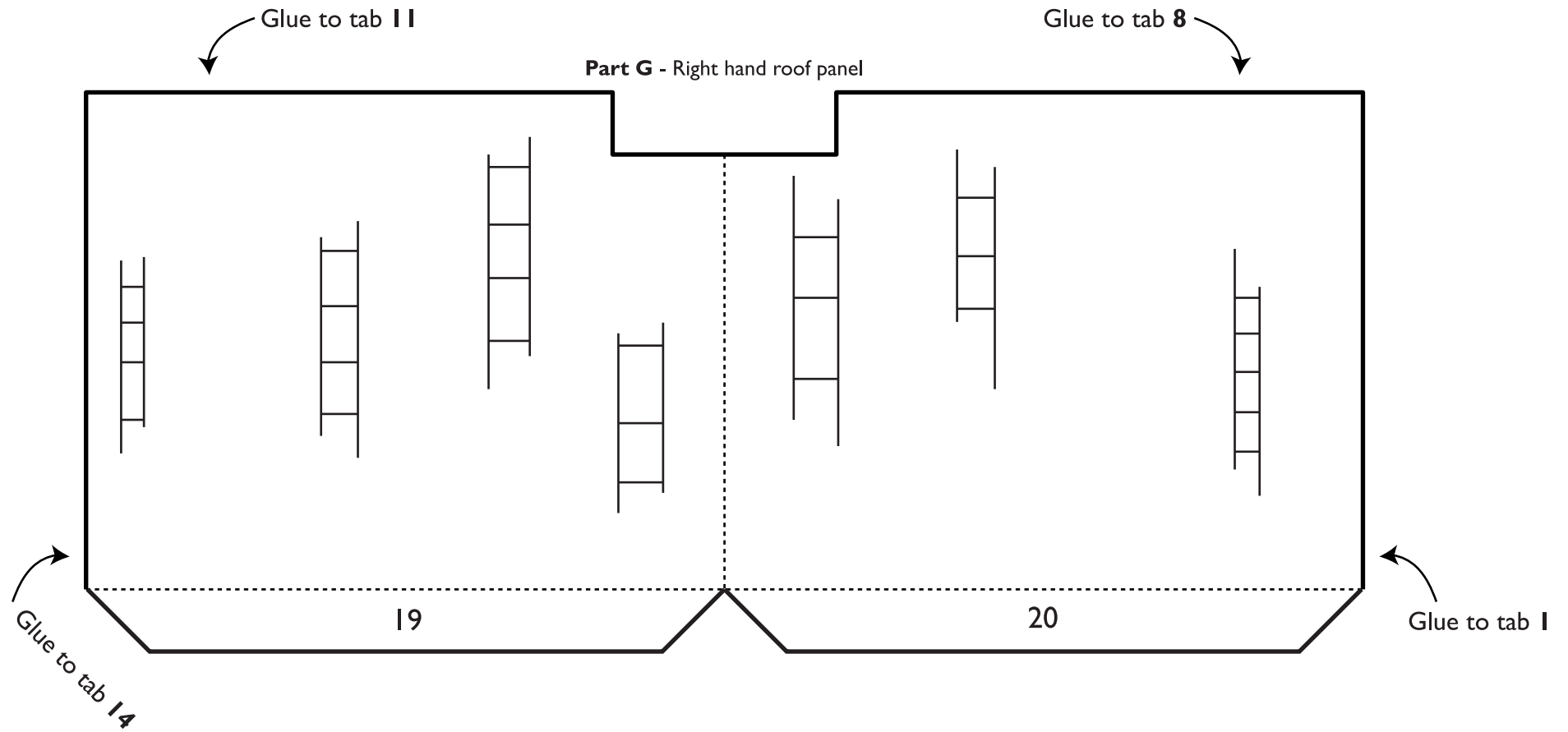


Cut and fold **Part E** and **Part F**. Fold out tab **16** at a right angle and bend **Part F** so it resembles a semi-circle. Glue tabs **17** and **18** to the inside of **Part E** so they cannot be seen and glue the small tabs of tab **16** to the inside of **Part F**.

Glue **Part E** to tab **12** as indicated and then glue **Part D** to tab **15** as indicated. Finally, glue **Part D** to tab **4**. The structure of the building should now be complete.

Part F - Snug

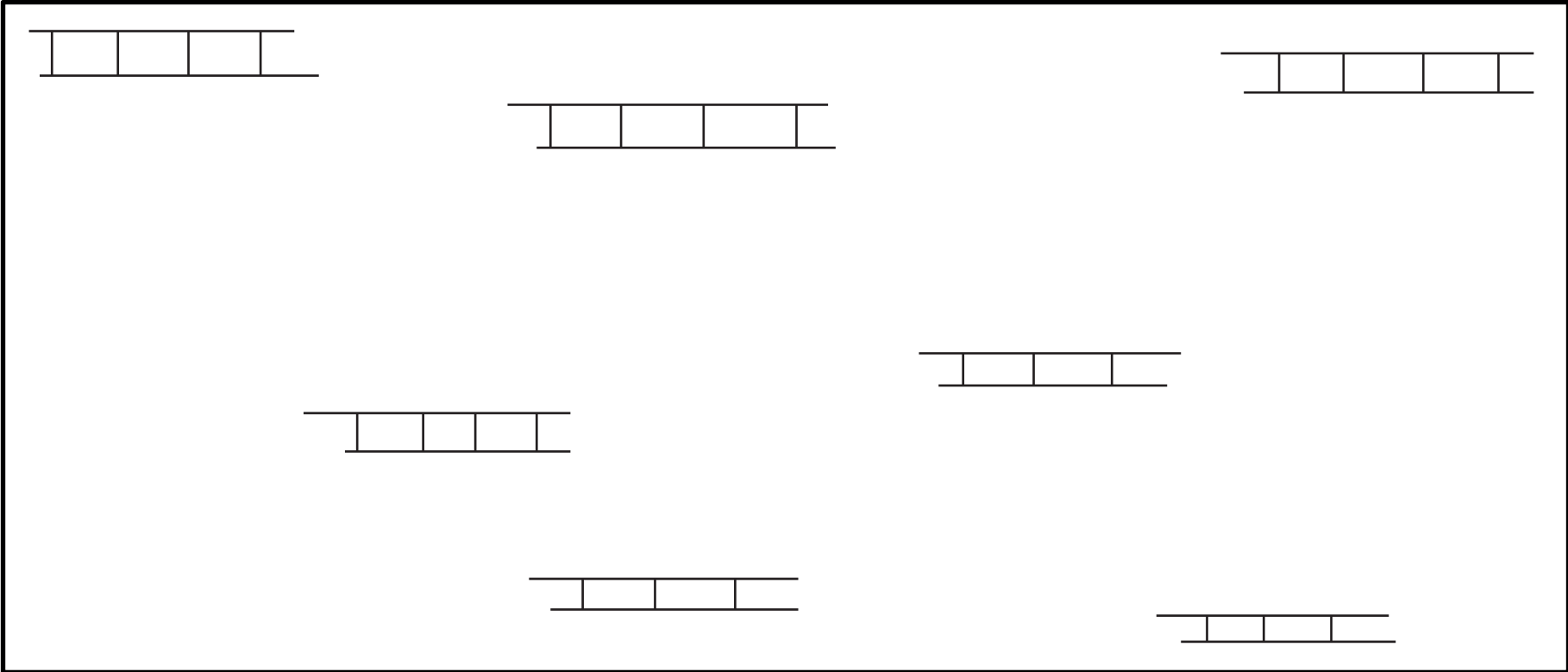




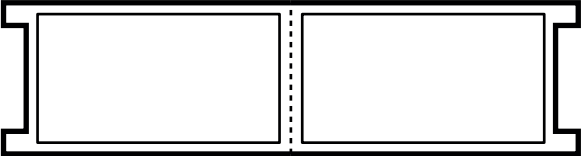
Cut and fold **Part G**, folding down the centre line, and then glue to tabs **1**, **8**, **11** and **14** on the main body of the building as indicated.

Now cut and fold **Parts H** and **J** which are on the next two pages, gluing tab **21** to **Part H**. Glue the completed roof to tabs **19** and **20** and the remaining tabs left on the body of the building.

Part H - Left hand roof panel

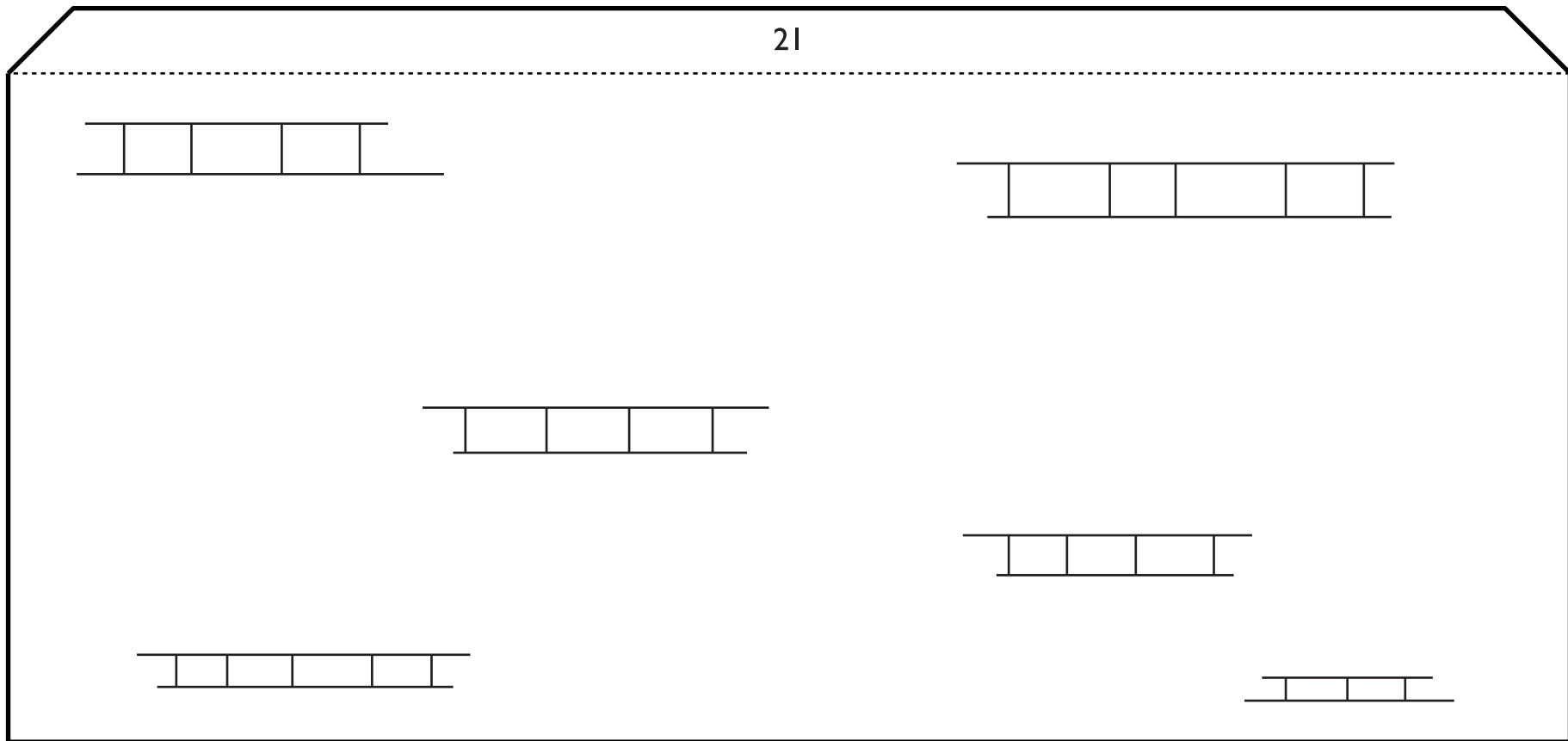


Part I - A-frame
